“Peoples of the Susquehanna River,” an original documentary film produced by Bucknell University and WVIA Public Media, will be shown at the Capitol Restaurant in Bloomsburg on Thursday, March 15, 2018. The one-hour program examines the history, cultures, and traditions of the Native Americans of the Susquehanna River watershed.

The film explores tribes of the Eastern Woodlands, the Susquehannocks, the Lenni Lenape, and the Six Nations of the Iroquois Confederacy, as well as findings of varied prehistoric tribes whose existence dates back over 1,000 years ago.
