DIRT, GRAVEL, & LOW VOLUME ROAD TECHNICIAN

The Columbia County Conservation District is accepting applications for a full-time position to administer the Dirt, Gravel, and Low Volume Road (DGLVR) Technician Program. The DGLVR position is responsible for the successful implementation and full administration of the DGLVR Program. The position requires knowledge of and the ability to use various software packages that provide for the efficient administration of the DGLVR program. In-house technical knowledge necessary to evaluate DGLVR sites for potential pollution of waterways and to perform all elements of contract management for the program is required.

This position will also include duties as assigned by the Conservation District Board and District Manager such as technical assistance on watershed programs and projects that improve the quality of the commonwealth's surface and groundwater resources and support of watershed organizations and environmental education and outreach. The focus of this work relates to the creation and implementation of best management practices to restore and protect groundwater and surface water resources for both public and private sectors.

Strong communication, math, computer, and grant writing skills are required. B.S. in Environmental Science or related fields preferred or equivalent experience. Construction management/inspection experience a plus. Salary is based on District pay scale with excellent benefit package. Must possess and maintain a valid Pennsylvania driver's license. Pennsylvania and Federal clearances are required.
