

Cover Crop Roller

The Columbia, Montour, & Northumberland County Conservation Districts have available for rent a 6' wide crop roller with a 3 pt. hitch mount and a horse drawn mounting cart. The goal of this project is to demonstrate the successful use of rolling tall mature cover crops as a means to improve soil health on local farms while reducing production costs and improving water quality and infiltration.

Looking for farms willing to roll a tall mature cover crop in later spring and No-Till transplant directly into the rolled cover

OR

Producers willing to roll cover and plant row crops like corn or pumpkins directly into rolled cover.

Diverse Species Cover Crop Incentive Program

Improving soil health by incorporating diverse species cover crop mixes into a systems approach to regenerating soils and profits on farms.

The Columbia, Montour, & Northumberland County Conservation Districts are offering a Diverse Cover Crop Incentive Program. The goal of the program is to demonstrate the successful use of cover crops as a means to improve soil health on local farms while reducing production costs and improving water quality and infiltration. Soil health will be improved through a systems approach including No-Till and diverse species cover cropping.

Diverse Species Cover Crop Mixes

- Enhanced weed suppression/control
- Reduced production costs
- Improved soil health
- Enhanced nutrient cycling
- Soil armor (erosion protection)
- Improved soil moisture holding capacity
- Improved soil structure (Increased infiltration)
- Enhanced habitat for beneficial insects

Guidelines for the Incentive Program:

- Acreage applied for must be located in Columbia, Montour, or Northumberland Counties.
- This is a two year program 2018-2019
- To be eligible, you must be planting cover crops for the first time. OR if you have previously planted cover crops you must be willing to plant multi species and plant them on acres that have never received cover crops previously.
- Cover must be established via No-Till drill or broadcast seeded.
- If you participated in the program before you can re-enroll for \$15.00 / acre.
- Cover crops planted in this program cannot be harvested for grain. Forage harvesting / grazing is acceptable.
- Option to utilize the “Haney Soil Test” / Soil Health Tool
- Late planted cover crops cannot be terminated earlier than 7 days prior to planting.
- Attendance at the Conservation District’s Spring Soil Health Conference or one local Conservation District sponsored field day is required or second year eligibility will be terminated.
- There is a 100 acre cap per operator.
- Diverse mixes must include a minimum of 3 species. One species must overwinter. (ex. Winter grain)
- Cover crops must be planted by November 15th.
- Incentive rates will vary from \$15/acre for program re-enrollees to \$45/acre for new applicants.
- All seed must be certified. Bin run seed must be cleaned and tested for germination and noxious weeds.
- Seed tags must be submitted for practice completion and payment certification.
- Incentive payments will be reimbursable. Payments may take up to 6 months after planting of cover crops. This is due to the funding source.
