CONTEST RULES:

1. Posters will be judged in five categories: K-1, 2-3, 4-6, 7-9, & 10-12
2. Posters must be **14" X 22"** (half a poster).
3. A written theme must be on the front of the poster.
4. No artist name may appear on the front of the poster.
5. To qualify, the back of the poster must be clearly labeled with
 - a. student name
 - b. grade
 - c. school name, address, & phone #
 - d. teacher name
6. Theme "Life in the Soil: Dig Deeper" **MUST** be included on the front side of each poster to be eligible for the National Poster Contest.
7. Poster must be created by an individual student. One entry per student.
8. Poster must be the original artwork of the student.
9. Open to students in Columbia County.
10. All 1st place entries will be entered into the National Poster Contest.

What Makes a Good Poster?

- Colorful posters are best! Use markers, paint, colored pencils, crayons, charcoal, stickers, etc.
- Hand-drawn or digital posters accepted.
- Balance a combination of illustrations and words.
- Text should be large enough to be easily read. Be as neat as you can be.
- Use colors and white space effectively-attract attention.
- Research the theme as a way to brainstorm ideas.
